Leg #1: Troubling Statistics...

- 48% of pastors think being in ministry is hazardous to family well-being
- 80% of pastors say they have insufficient time with their spouse
- 58% of pastors indicate their spouse works either part-time or full-time outside the home because the family needs the income
- 45% of pastors' wives say the greatest danger to them and family is physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual burnout
- 70% do not have someone they consider a close friend

Leg #1: Troubling Statistics...

- 80% of pastors believe pastoral ministry has negatively affected their families
- 90% of pastors feel they are inadequately trained to cope with the demands of ministry
- 70% say they have a lower self-image now than when they first started
- The profession of Pastor is near the bottom of a survey of the most-respected professions
- More than 50% of all pastors are so discouraged that they regularly consider leaving the ministry



Leg #2: “Real Life” Issues That Pastors Face...That Nobody’s Talking About

Issue #1: Life Balance...Personal/Professional/Physical/Emotional/Spiritual

- 90% of pastors feel they are inadequately trained to cope with the demands of ministry
- 45% of pastors’ wives say the greatest danger to them and family is physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual burnout
- The profession of Pastor is near the bottom of a survey of the most-respected professions

Issue #2: Marriage and Family

- 48% of pastors think being in ministry is hazardous to family well-being
- 80% of pastors’ wives feel left out and unappreciated by the church members
- 80% of pastors’ wives wish their spouse would choose another profession
- 80% of pastors say they have insufficient time with their spouse

Issue #3: Discouragement

- 70% say they have a lower self-image now than when they first started
- More than 50% of all pastors are so discouraged that they regularly consider leaving the ministry
- 70% do not have someone they consider a close friend

Issue #4: Leadership/Administration/Management

- 85% of pastors said their greatest struggle is dealing with problem people...
- 90% said the ministry was completely different than what they thought it would be before they began

Issue #5: Compensation

- Nobody’s talking about ‘it’...so we’re talking about it now
- Where are the statistics?
- Here’s one-58% of pastors indicate their spouse works wither part-time or full-time outside the home because the family needs the income
